Installing Net Posts

- When installing posts, make sure they will rest no higher than 1" above the net cord, at a height of about 3'- 6" above the court surface. The footings should be a minimum of 3' - 6" below surface or to the frost depth of your area. (see diagram)
- 2. Place footings so that the center line of the posts will be 3' outside the court on each side.
- 3. The center lines of posts should be positioned 42'

- apart for Doubles court and 33' apart for Singles court. Post sleeves are recommended because they allow easy removal of the posts for resurfacing, maintenance, post repair/replacement, and alternate uses of the court.
- 4. During the off season or when winterizing, it is best to remove the net posts and plug the sleeves with sleeve covers to prevent moisture and dirt from falling in.
